
RE: Recommendation regarding RFP 17-15 Re-paving Existing Asphalt Driving Course

MESSAGE:

Of the three contractors who attended the mandatory pre-bid conference regarding the subject RFP, only two responded, Ajax Paving Industries and Gator Grading and Paving. Due to the disparity between the pricing we called for a Best and Final Offer from each Proposer which was to represent the total project price including the previously separated per square yard base layer patching.

The Best and Final offers were much closer together. However, the evaluators have recommended that due to the high cost of the project and the low number of responses received, no award be made and the Request for Proposal be re-issued.
